Parent Right to Know

You have the right to know the professional qualifications of the educators who instruct your child. Federal law allows you to obtain certain information in a timely manner about your child's classroom teachers and instructional assistants/ paraprofessionals. You have the right to ask for the following information about each of our child's teachers and instructional assistants/paraprofessionals:

- 1. The teacher's Florida certification area(s) and,
 - a. if the teacher is teaching infield, or
 - b. if the teacher is qualified infield according to the District School Board of Pasco County.
- 2. The teacher's college degree(s) and areas of study.
- 3. The teacher's advanced college degree(s) and areas of study.
- 4. The qualifications of any instructional assistant/paraprofessionals who provide services to your child.

In addition, you have the right to be provided information on your student's level of achievement on assessments in reading/language arts, mathematics and science. Please contact your teacher.

FREE Breakfast and Lunch for All

Starting on Monday, September 14, students who attend class on campus will still be able to get meals in the school cafeteria, and now those meals will be free. Also starting on Monday, September 14, students who attend school remotely will still be able to receive school meals on a drive-through basis. Those meals also will be free.


Here's how the program will work for students who are learning remotely through mySchool Online or Pasco eSchool:

Monday, September 14 through Thursday, September 17, the daily drive-through meal distribution will continue at the designated site time – and meals will now be free. Designated locations and times are listed at

On Friday, September 18, the school district will serve a week's worth of meals (breakfast and lunch) curbside to mySchool Online students, quarantined students, and children in the community 18 years and under. That includes Pasco e-School students. We will keep the same times already established for curbside feeding. Curbside meal distribution will continue once a week on Fridays.

We encourage families intending to participate curbside to complete the Meal Reservation Form, <u>http://www.pasco.k12.fl.us/fns/mform/view.php?id</u> <u>=269401</u>, so we can be best prepared for curbside participation.





Eligible students can receive a sack of breakfast and lunch items every Friday to provide food over the weekend.
